

Land East of Horndean

Public Exhibition - Thursday 31st July 3pm to 8pm at
Napier Hall, Horndean



As you may recall, we held a public exhibition at Merchistoun Hall in April 2014 to present our initial thoughts for a comprehensive development (including approximately 700 new homes, elderly persons accommodation, employment opportunities, playing fields and community facilities) at Land East of Horndean. The event was attended by approximately 500 local residents who provided us with very helpful views on the proposals and a clearer understanding of what facilities are needed in the community. Having collated and reviewed all of the feedback received at the first exhibition, we have sought to refine our proposals to reflect and respond to local views.

With this in mind, we would like to invite you to attend a second public exhibition showing the evolution of our proposals and presenting a more detailed masterplan for the site. The purpose of this exhibition is to offer you, as a local resident, the opportunity to comment on and further influence our proposals as we move towards the submission of a formal planning application.

As with the previous exhibition, members of the project team will be on hand to answer any questions that you may have. During the event we will also provide attendees with a comment form and we would encourage you to provide your views.

The exhibition is an informal event and is being held in Napier Hall, Portsmouth Road, Horndean, PO8 9NL in the afternoon and evening of Thursday 31st July 2014 between 3:00pm and 8:00pm (please visit at anytime between these hours).
